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## **1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is the *Confiscation of Criminal Assets (Distribution of Surplus Funds) Approval 2025 (No 2)*.

## **2 Commencement**

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

## **3 Approvals of use of distributable funds**

## **4 Reporting requirement**

- Provide evidence to show that the funding has been used in accordance with the approved application and the purposes at section 134 of the *Confiscation of Criminal Assets Act 2003*.

## **5 Time requirement**

It is a condition of the approvals in clause (3) of this instrument that agencies approved for funding expend the approved funds by 30 June 2026 or as otherwise approved in writing by the Minister.
