# Financial Management (Performance Criteria) Amendment 2026 (No 2)\*

**Notifiable instrument NI2026–273**

UNDER SECTION 19D OF THE *FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT ACT 1996*

---

This statement outlines the reasons for amending performance criteria under Section 19D of the *Financial Management Act 1996* (FMA).

Section 19D of the FMA allows for the transfer by notifiable instrument of performance criteria from Chief Minister and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) to the City and Environment Directorate (CED). The accountability indicators in Schedule A are being amended to reflect the transfer of functions from the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate to City and Environment Directorate as a result of the commencement of Administrative Arrangements Order 2025 (2) (NI2025-686), dated 19 December 2025.

**Instrument Amendment:**

The amended 2025-26 Accountability Indicators for CMTEDD and CED are set out in Schedule A.

## Schedule B

Administrative Arrangements Order 2025 (2) (NI2025-686), dated 19 December 2025, transferred responsibility for the functions of affordable and community housing policy, and housing strategy and policy, from CMTEDD to CED. These new Administrative Arrangements commenced on 1 January 2026.

The functions transferred between CMTEDD and CED have two corresponding accountability indicators specified in the 2025-26 budget papers.

Indicator 4.1 h) Publish the annual ACT Housing Strategy report card has not yet been completed, and is transferred from CMTEDD to CED in this instrument.
