THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 1 of 1917.

AN ORDINANCE

To provide for the administration of the "Inflammable Liquid Act 1915" of the State of New South Wales in the Territory for the Seat of Government.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909, and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Inflammable Liquid Short title. Ordinance 1917.
- 2. The Governor-General may arrange with the Governor in Administration Council of the State of New South Wales for the administration, of Inflammable Inflammable Liquid Act 1915 of that State, (N.S.W.) in the by the authorities of that State as if the Territory continued to form part of that State, and, thereupon, that Act shall, so long as the arrangement remains in force, be administered in the Territory by the authorities of that State as if the Territory continued to form part of that State.
