

## DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY.

No. 6 of 1923.<sup>(a)</sup>

**An Ordinance to provide for the delegation of the powers and functions of the Minister to the Commonwealth Surveyor-General and Director of Lands.**

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Delegation of Authority Ordinance 1923*. Short title.

2.—(1.) The Minister may by writing under his hand delegate any of his powers or functions under any Ordinance (except any power of delegation under that Ordinance) to the Commonwealth Surveyor-General and Director of Lands, so that the delegated powers may be exercised by the delegate as fully and effectually as by the Minister.

(2.) Every delegation under this section shall be revocable in writing at will, and no delegation shall prevent the exercise of any power by the Minister.

(3.) Every delegation under this section and every instrument revoking any such delegation shall be notified in the *Gazette*.
