AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1930*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1930*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927-1930*.

2. Section three of the *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927* is amended—

(a) by inserting in sub-section (1.), after the words “The Anniversary of the Birthday of the Sovereign;”, the words “Eight Hours Day”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (4.) the words “the twenty-sixth day of January, or”.
