THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 20 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

**Relating to the Term of Office of elected members of
the Advisory Council.**

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1931*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance* (No. 2) 1933. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (4.) of section four of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1932*, the persons elected or appointed in pursuance of that Ordinance as members of the Advisory Council and holding office at the commencement of this Ordinance shall, subject to the provisions of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1932*, continue to hold office until the eighteenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four. Extension of term of office of elected members.

3. The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1933* is repealed. Repeal.
