THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 24 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance*
1926-1929.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1933 as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance* 1933. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance* 1926-1929 is in this Ordinance referred to as the *Principal Ordinance*.

(3.) The *Principal Ordinance*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance* 1926-1933.

2. Section two of the *Principal Ordinance* is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“2. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions.
‘foreign lottery’ means any lottery conducted or to be conducted outside the Territory which is not authorized by or under, and conducted or to be conducted in accordance with, the law of any State or Territory, whether it is described as a lottery or as a sweep or consultation or by any other name or designation;

‘lottery’ does not include a lottery which is authorized by or under, and conducted or to be conducted in accordance with, the law of any State or Territory.”
