THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 7 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Juries Ordinances 1932*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1931*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Juries Ordinance 1933*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Juries Ordinances 1932* is in this Ordinance referred to as the *Principal Ordinance*.

(3.) The *Principal Ordinance*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Juries Ordinance 1932-1933*.

2. Section eight of the *Principal Ordinance* is amended—

Persons exempt.

(a) by omitting from paragraph (g) the word “and” (last occurring); and

(b) by adding at the end of the section the following paragraphs:—

“ (s) The Chairman and Members of the Board of Commissioners appointed under the *Commonwealth Public Service Act 1922-1932*;

(t) The Commissioner of Taxation and the Second Commissioner of Taxation appointed under the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1922-1932*; and

(u) The officers for the time being occupying the following positions:—

(i) Director of the Commonwealth Solar Observatory;

(ii) Inspector General of Forests;

(iii) Professor of Comparative Anatomy;

(iv) Chief of the Division of Plant Industry;

(v) Chief of the Division of Economic Entomology; and

(vi) Geological Adviser to the Commonwealth Government.”

Preparation of
jury lists.

3. Section fourteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) the word "ten" and inserting in its stead the word "eight".

Revision of
lists.

4. Section fifteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "words 'Special Juror'" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "letters 'S.J.'".

Peremptory
challengers in
criminal trials.

5. Section thirty-five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word "fifteen" and inserting in its stead the word "eight".
