THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 22 of 1934.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1934.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance (No. 2) 1934*.

Short title and citation.

(2.) Sub-section (3.) of section one of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1934* is repealed.

(3.) The *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928*, as amended by the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1934*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1934*.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of the commencement of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928*.

Commencement.

3. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, at the commencement of sub-section (1.), the words "Except where otherwise expressly provided,".

Non-application of Ordinance to certain members of the Force.

4. Section eighteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-sections:—

Refund of deductions on retirement, &c.

"(4.) This section shall, subject to the next succeeding sub-section, apply to and in relation to any member of the Police Force who was, immediately prior to his appointment as such a member, a member of the Police Force of a State; and for the purposes of such application the expression 'rateable deductions' shall be deemed to mean contributions made to the Consolidated Revenue Fund in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (3.) of section three of this Ordinance.

“(5.) Where, independently of the last preceding sub-section—

- (a) any such member of the Police Force is entitled to, or eligible for, a refund of the whole or any part of the rateable deductions which have been made from his pay; or
- (b) the whole or any part of the rateable deductions may be applied for the benefit of his wife or children (if any),

no refund or application of rateable deductions shall, in that case, be made under this section, except to the extent to which the amount of the rateable deductions which is, or may be, repayable or applicable under this section, exceeds the amount of rateable deductions which is or may be repayable or applicable independently of this section.”.
