No. 11 of 1935.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the **Liquor Ordinance 1929-1932**, as amended by the **Liquor Ordinance 1935**.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor Ordinance* Short title and citation.
(No. 2) 1935.

(2.) Section one of the *Liquor Ordinance 1935* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(3.) The *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1932*, as amended by the *Liquor Ordinance 1935*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1935*.

2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the definition of "Lessee" and inserting in its stead the following definition:— Definition of "Lessee".

"'Lessee', in relation to premises, means a person, body corporate or firm to whom or which a lease of the premises has been granted by the Commonwealth and includes a sub-lessee under any such lease;".

3. Section nineteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word "occupying" and inserting in its stead the word "of". Residential Hotel Licence.

4. Section twenty-three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (3.) the word "occupying" and inserting in its stead the word "of". Café Licences.
