THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 16 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Housing Ordinance 1928-1930.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1935, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance* 1936. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Housing Ordinance* 1928-1930 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance* 1928-1936.

2. After section six of the Principal Ordinance the following section is added:—

“7. Where in any mortgage entered into in connexion with any advance made, whether under section four of the *Housing Ordinance* 1928, or that Ordinance as amended, or otherwise, for any purpose specified in paragraph (e) of that section, reference is made to the Federal Capital Commission or to the Commonwealth, and the Federal Capital Commission or the Commonwealth is a party to the mortgage, the reference shall be read as a reference to the Commissioner and the Commissioner shall be deemed to be a party to the mortgage in lieu of the Federal Capital Commission or the Commonwealth, as the case may be.” Reference in mortgages to the Federal Capital Commission and to the Commonwealth.
