No. 22 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Hospital Tax Ordinance 1935.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Hospital Tax Ordinance 1936*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Hospital Tax Ordinance 1935* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Hospital Tax Ordinance 1935-1936*.

2. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended.

(a) by adding at the end of sub-section (2.) the following proviso:—

“Provided that, in respect of the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, the hospital tax payable by any person to whom this sub-section applies shall be One pound fourteen shillings.”; and

(b) by inserting after sub-section (2.) the following sub-section:—

“(2A.) Where, in respect of the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, any person to whom the proviso to the last preceding sub-section applies pays, or has paid, to the Commissioner by way of hospital tax a sum which exceeds the sum of One pound fourteen shillings, the Commissioner shall refund to that person the amount by which the sum so paid exceeds the sum of One pound fourteen shillings.”.
