THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 28 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Juvenile Offenders (Detention) Ordinance 1935.

B it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Juvenile Offender's short title and (Detention) Ordinance 1936.

(2.) The Juvenile Offenders (Detention) Ordinance 1935 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be eited as the Juvenile Offenders (Detention) Ordinance 1936.

2. After section five of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

"5A. Section five of the Act is amended by adding at the end interpretation. of the definition of 'Child' the words 'and, in the provisions relating to institutions and the committal of children to institutions, means boy or girl under eighteen years of age'."
