AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1935*.

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and
over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of
the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers
conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the
Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council* Short title
and citation.
Ordinance 1936.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1935*, as amended
by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance*
1930-1936.

2. Section four of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1935* Constitution
of Advisory
Council.
is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words “The
Director-General of Health;” and inserting in their stead the words
“An officer of the Department of Health appointed by the Minis-
ter of State for Health to be a member of the Council;”.
