THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 5 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Nurses Registration Ordinances 1933.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1936*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Nurses Registration Ordinances 1933* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933-1936*.

2. Section twenty-two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (i) (b) of sub-section (5.) the words "one year" and "six" and inserting in their stead the words "eighteen months" and "nine". Persons entitled to registration.
