THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 9 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Public Baths Ordinances 1931.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Baths Ordinance 1936*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Public Baths Ordinances 1931* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1936*.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the definition of "Swimming season" and inserting in its stead the following definition:— Definitions.

"'Swimming season' means the period commencing on the first day of November in any year or any day prior to that day that the Minister may determine and ending on the thirty-first day of March in the following year or any day prior to or subsequent to that day that the Minister may determine."

3. After section six of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

"6AA. The Minister may determine that the swimming season shall— Minister may determine swimming season.

(a) commence on any day prior to the first day of November in any year, and

(b) end on any day prior to or subsequent to the thirty-first day of March in any following year."
