## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the **Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927-1936.**

**B**E it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1937*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927-1936* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Ordinance 1927-1937*.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Holidays. inserting in sub-section (1.), after the words "The Anniversary of the Birthday of the Sovereign;", the words "The first Monday in August;".
