THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 16 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1936 as amended by the Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1937 and by the Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance (No. 2) of 1937.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance (No. 3) 1937*.

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1936*, as amended by the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1937* and by the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance (No. 2) 1937*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Sub-section (4.) of section one of the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance (No. 2) 1937* is repealed.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1937*.

2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in sub-section (3.), after the word "Board", the words "or until the date of the next election, whichever first happens,".

Term of office of non-official members of Board.
