THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 17 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1937*.

Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—

Constitution of
Advisory
Council.

“(4.) After the date specified in the last preceding sub-section, the persons elected in pursuance of this Ordinance as members of the Council shall, subject to this Ordinance, hold office for a period of two years commencing on the day of their election or the day immediately following the day on which their predecessors cease to hold office, whichever last happens, and shall be eligible for re-election.”
