No. 18 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926-1936.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Dogs Registration Ordinance 1937*. Short title.

(2.) The *Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926-1936* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926-1937*.

2. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end of sub-section (2.) the following words:— Registration of dogs.

“, and a metal disc, of a size determined by the Registrar, having thereon a representation of the Canberra Coat of Arms, the registration number, particulars of the period for which the dog is registered and such other particulars as the Registrar thinks fit.”

3. After section seven of the Principal Ordinance insert the following section:— Registration disc.

“7A. Any person who—

- (a) without lawful authority or excuse, prints or manufactures, or has in his possession or under his control or upon his premises, a disc so nearly resembling a disc issued in pursuance of the last preceding section (in this Ordinance referred to as a registration disc) as to be likely to deceive;
- (b) alters or defaces a registration disc;
- (c) buys or sells any disc so nearly resembling a registration disc as to be likely to deceive; or
- (d) without lawful authority or excuse, removes from any dog a registration disc or collar to which a registration disc is attached;

shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Five pounds.”

4. Section thirteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) the words "with the name and address of the keeper legibly engraved thereon" and inserting in their stead the words "having attached thereto a registration disc issued by the Registrar in respect of that dog for the year then current".
