# AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 15 of 1939.

## AN ORDINANCE

**Relating to the renewal of licences granted under the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938 and for other purposes.**

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor (Renewal of Licences) Ordinance 1939*. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938*, where the Magistrate has, during the month of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, granted a renewal of a licence, the fee fixed by the Magistrate for the renewal of the licence may be paid to and accepted by the Registrar on or before the twenty-third day of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, and the fee, if so paid and accepted, shall be deemed to have been paid and accepted on the twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, and the Registrar shall issue a licence accordingly under the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938*, and any licence so issued shall be as valid and effectual as if the fee had been paid and accepted on the twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine. Validation of certain payments and licences.

3. Words and expressions used in this Ordinance shall, unless the contrary intention appears, have the same meanings as in the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938*. Interpretation.
