AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1938*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1939*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1938* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1939*.

2. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Administration of Ordinances.

(a) by adding at the end of paragraph (d) the word “and”;

(b) by omitting from paragraph (e) the word “and”; and

(c) by omitting paragraph (f).

3. The Fifth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following schedule inserted in its stead:— The Fifth Schedule.
