AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 1 of 1940.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1939.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1940*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1939* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1940*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the definition of "organization" the words "to which" and inserting in their stead the words "and any employer to which or to whom". Definition of "organization".

3. Section fifteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "or to any employer who satisfies the Attorney-General that he has, throughout the six months next preceding the date of his application for a declaration, employed on the average taken per month not less than twenty-five employees and that there is no organization to which he might conveniently belong". Application of Ordinance to declared persons.

4. After section nineteen AA of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

"19AB. All Courts shall in proceedings under this Ordinance take judicial notice of any certificate purporting to be signed by the Commonwealth Statistician or by any person authorized in that behalf by the Commonwealth Statistician and to contain statistics or abstracts thereof compiled and tabulated by the Commonwealth Statistician and any such certificate shall be *prima facie* evidence of the matter contained in the certificate." Judicial notice to be taken of certificate of Commonwealth Statistician.
