No. 21 of 1940.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1940.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance (No. 2) 1940*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) Section one of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1940* is amended by omitting sub-section (2.).

(3.) The *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1938*, as amended by the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1940*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1940*.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:— Non-application of Ordinance to certain members of the Force.

“(b) any person who at the date of the commencement of this paragraph is a member of the Police Force and who was, immediately prior to his appointment as such a member, a member of the Police Force of a State, and who does not elect, in accordance with the provisions of section three A of this Ordinance, to be a member of the Police Force to whom this Ordinance applies.”.

3. After section three of the Principal Ordinance the following sections are inserted:—

“3A.—(1.) Any person who at the date of the commencement of this section is a member of the Police Force and who was, immediately prior to his appointment as such a member, a member of the Police Force of a State, may, within three months after the commencement of this section, elect to be a member of the Police Force to whom this Ordinance applies, and, as from the date of that election, the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to that person. Election by ex-members of State Force to come under this Ordinance.

“(2.) Any variations in the rate of deductions from the pay of any member of the Police Force resulting from an election in pursuance of this section shall have effect from and including the first deduction made after the date of that election.

“3B.—(1.) Any member of the Police Force who was, immediately prior to his appointment as such a member, a member of the Police Force of a State, may, within three months after his appointment or within twelve months after the commencement of this section, whichever is the later date, pay to the Consolidated Revenue Fund an amount equal to the sum of any contributions made by that member to a superannuation or similar fund established in respect of members of the Police Force of the State of which he was a member and thereupon his service as a member of the Police Force of that State shall, for all the purposes of this Ordinance, be deemed to be service as a member of the Police Force.

“(2.) Moneys paid to the Consolidated Revenue Fund in accordance with sub-section (1.) of this section shall, for all the purposes of this Ordinance, be deemed to be rateable deductions from the member by whom they are paid.”

Schedule.

4. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting the table contained in Part I. and inserting in its stead the following table:—
