## AN ORDINANCE

### Relating to the Renewal of Licences granted under the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor (Renewal of Licences) Ordinance 1940*. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938*, where the Magistrate, during the month of December, One thousand nine hundred and forty, granted a renewal of a licence, the fee fixed by the Magistrate for the renewal of the licence may be paid to and accepted by the Registrar on or before the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and forty, and the fee, if so paid and accepted, shall be deemed to have been paid and accepted on the twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and forty, and the Registrar shall issue a licence accordingly under the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938*, and any licence so issued shall be as valid and effectual as if the fee had been paid and accepted on the twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and forty. Authority for issue of certain licences.

3. Words and expressions used in this Ordinance shall, unless the contrary intention appears, have the same meanings as in the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1938*. Interpretation.
