AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Police Superannuation Ordinance*
1928-1938.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909-1938 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1939, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1940. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1928-1938, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1928-1940.

2. After section fifteen of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1928-1938, the following section is inserted:—

“15A. Where any grantee of a superannuation allowance is appointed a special constable under section twelve of the *Police Ordinance* 1927-1938, his superannuation allowance shall be suspended during the continuance of his appointment as a special constable, but shall be restored as from the date of the termination of that appointment.” Suspension of allowance where grantee appointed special constable.
