## AN ORDINANCE

**To suspend the operation of sub-section (7.) of section six of the Gun Licence Ordinance 1937-1938.**

**B**E it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Gun Licence (Fees Suspension) Ordinance 1943*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title.

2. The operation of sub-section (7.) of section six of the *Gun Licence Ordinance 1937-1938* is hereby suspended until the thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, and may thereafter be suspended from time to time by the Minister, by notice published in the *Gazette*, for such further period as is specified in the notice. Suspension of fees.
