AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1941.

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1944*.^{*} Short title.

(2.) The *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1941*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1944*.

2. After section seven of the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1941*, the following section is inserted:—

“7A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Ordinance, the elected members of the Board representative of the skilled tradesmen and unskilled workers and the deputies of those members whose term of office expired on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-four shall, subject to this Ordinance, continue to hold office until the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five.” Continuance in office of elected members of the Board.
