

# AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 7 of 1945.

## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Trustee Act Amendment Act, 1902, of the State of New South Wales, in its application to the Territory.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trustee Ordinance 1945*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title.

(2.) The *Trustee Ordinance 1944*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trustee Ordinance 1944-1945*.

2. Section eleven of the Trustee Act Amendment Act, 1902, of the State of New South Wales, in its application to the Territory, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(4.) This section applies to trusts created before or after the commencement of this section.”
