AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1945.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1946*.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1945*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1946*.

2. Section three B of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1945* is amended by omitting the words “three months after his appointment or within twelve months after the commencement of this section, whichever is the later date” and inserting in their stead the words “six months after the date of taking up his duties as a member of the Police Force”. Former members of the Police Force of a State.
