AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1946.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance (No. 2) 1946*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) Section one of the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1946* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(3) The *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1945*, as amended by the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1946*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936-1946*.

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the names of the following organizations:— The Second Schedule.

“Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners,
Australian Capital Territory Bricklayers' Union.”

and inserting in their stead the names of the following organizations:—

“Amalgamated Engineering Union,
Building Workers Industrial Union of Australia.”
