AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Housing Ordinance 1928-1940.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance 1947*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Housing Ordinance 1928-1940*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance 1928-1947*.

2. Section five e of the *Housing Ordinance 1928-1940* is amended—^{Operation of Trust Account.}

(a) by inserting in sub-section (2.), after the words “Commonwealth Bank”, the words “or to the Commonwealth Savings Bank”; and

(b) by omitting from that sub-section the words “that Bank” and inserting in their stead the words “either of those Banks”.
