## AN ORDINANCE

### To Proclaim a Commonwealth Jubilee Holiday.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Commonwealth Jubilee Holiday Ordinance 1951*\*. Short title.

2. Tuesday, the twelfth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, is proclaimed as a holiday in the Territory, in celebration of the completion of the first fifty years from the establishment of the Commonwealth of Australia. Proclamation of holiday.
