AN ORDINANCE

To Proclaim a Holiday in Celebration of the Royal Visit.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Royal Visit Holiday Ordinance 1954*.^{*} Short title.

2. Monday, the fifteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, is proclaimed as a holiday in the Territory, in celebration of the visit of Her Majesty the Queen to the Territory. Proclamation of holiday.
