AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-52.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1947, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance* 1955.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance* 1938-1952† as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance* 1938-1955.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the first day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six. Commencement.

3. Section six of the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance* 1938-1952 is amended— Constitution of the Board.

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word “six” and inserting in its stead the word “eight”; and

(b) by omitting from that sub-section the word “one” and inserting in its stead the word “three”.

4. Nothing in this Ordinance affects the tenure of office of the persons who were, immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance, members of the Canberra Community Hospital Board. Tenure of office of members.
