AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Housing Ordinance 1928-1947*.

HOUSING ORDINANCE 1957.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance 1957*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Housing Ordinance 1928-1947*† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance 1928-1957*.

2. Sections five and five A of the Principal Ordinance are repealed and the following sections inserted in their stead:—

“ 5. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the Commissioner may accept advances made to him by a body corporate, institution, or person, approved by the Minister. ^{Advances to the Commissioner.}”

“ 5A. The Minister may guarantee the repayment, out of moneys lawfully made available by the Parliament for the purpose, of an advance accepted by the Commissioner under the last preceding section.” ^{Guarantee by the Minister.}

3. Section five c of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words " to the Commonwealth Bank or to the Commonwealth Savings Bank of advances made by either of those Banks " and inserting in their stead the words " of advances made ".
