AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1952*, as amended by the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1957*.

ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1957.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance (No. 2) 1957*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1952*,[†] as amended by the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1957*,[‡] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Section one of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1957* is amended by omitting sub-section (2.).

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1957*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (d) of sub-section (2.) the word "five" and inserting in its stead the word "six". Constitution of Advisory Council.

3. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word "five" and inserting in its stead the word "six". Election of members.

4. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting sub-sections (1.) and (2.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-sections:—

“ (1.) The members of the Council shall, at the first meeting of the Council held after an election, elect one of their members to be Chairman of the Council and another of their members to be Deputy Chairman of the Council.

“ (2.) Whenever the office of Chairman of the Council or the office of Deputy Chairman of the Council becomes vacant, the members of the Council shall, at the first meeting of the Council held after the vacancy occurs, elect one of their members to be Chairman of the Council or Deputy Chairman of the Council, as the case requires.”; and

(b) by omitting sub-section (5.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

“ (5.) The Chairman of the Council or the Deputy Chairman of the Council shall cease to hold office as such—

(a) if he ceases to be a member of the Council; or

(b) on the thirtieth day of September in the year in which the first election of members of the Council is held after he is elected to office.”.

Amendments
not to affect
existing

5. Notwithstanding the amendments made by this Ordinance, the provisions of the Principal Ordinance relating to meetings of the Advisory Council, the powers of the Council and rights of members of the Council continue to apply until the day immediately preceding the day on which the first meeting of the Council is held after the first election of members of the Council held after the commencement of this Ordinance.
