To amend the *Interpretation Ordinance 1937-1955*.

### INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance 1959*.\*

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Interpretation Ordinance 1937-1955*†, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance 1937-1959*.

2. After section eight of the *Interpretation Ordinance 1937-1955* the following section is inserted:—

“8A. In an Ordinance, a reference to the Judge of the Supreme Court shall, unless the contrary intention appears, be read as a reference to the Judge appointed under sub-section (1.) of section seven of the *Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court Act 1933-1958* or an additional Judge appointed under sub-section (2.) of section seven of that Act.”
