To amend the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1958*.

CANBERRA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1959*.*

Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1958*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1959*.

2. Section seven of the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1958* is amended by omitting sub-sections (3.) and (4.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-sections:—

Election of
members.

“(3.) An election of members of the Board shall be by ballot and the provisions of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1959*, the provisions of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918-1953* as they apply to and in relation to an election under that Ordinance and the provisions of the *Advisory Council Election Regulations* made under that Ordinance apply, subject to this section and to such exceptions, modifications and adaptations as are prescribed by regulations under this Ordinance, to

and in relation to an election of members of the Board in the same manner as they apply to an election of members of the Advisory Council under that Ordinance.

“(4.) For the purposes of the application of the provisions referred to in the last preceding sub-section—

- (a) a reference in those provisions to the Advisory Council shall be read as a reference to the Board;
- (b) a reference in those provisions to an election shall be read as a reference to an election of members of the Board; and
- (c) a reference in those provisions to the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936*, or to that Ordinance as amended from time to time, shall be read as a reference to this Ordinance.”
