## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance*  
1926-1937.

### LOTTERIES AND ART UNIONS ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance* 1959.\*

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance* 1926-1937† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance* 1926-1959.

2. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after the words "in any form" the words " , the sale of tickets for travel by road, rail, sea or air or for entry to sporting or cultural entertainments, or the disposal of any other benefit approved by the Minister".

3. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

Supervision  
of conduct.

“9.—(1.) The Commissioner of Police or a member of the Police Force of the Territory authorized by the Commissioner may, at any time, enter any bazaar or fancy fair and may supervise the conduct of any lottery or raffle held in connexion with that bazaar or fancy fair.

“ (2.) A person shall not obstruct or impede the Commissioner or a member of the Police Force in the exercise of his powers under this section.

Penalty: Twenty pounds.”.

4. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.), after the words “ articles of use or ornament ”, the words “ , the purchase of tickets for travel by road, rail, sea or air or for entry to sporting or cultural entertainments or the purchase of any other benefit approved by the Minister ”; and

(b) by adding at the end of sub-section (2.) the words “ , tickets for travel by road, rail, sea or air or for entry to sporting or cultural entertainments, or any other benefit approved by the Minister ”.

5. Section thirteen A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in sub-section (1.), after the words “ articles of use or ornament ”, the words “ , tickets for travel by road, rail, sea or air or for entry to sporting or cultural entertainments, or any other benefit approved by the Minister ”.
