ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1959*.*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1957*† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1959*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (d) of sub-section (2.) the word "six" and inserting in its stead the word "eight".

Constitution of Advisory Council.

3. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word "six" and inserting in its stead the word "eight".

Election of members.

4. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word "four" and inserting in its stead the word "seven".

Meetings of the Council.

not to affect
existing Council.

5. Notwithstanding the amendments made by this Ordinance, the provisions of the Principal Ordinance relating to meetings of the Advisory Council, the powers of the Council and rights of members of the Council continue to apply until the day immediately preceding the day on which the first meeting of the Council is held after the first election of members of the Council held after the commencement of this Ordinance.
