

## SEAT OF GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATION).

### No. 2 of 1963.

#### An Ordinance to amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1961.*

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1963.*<sup>\*</sup> Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1961*†, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1963.*

2. Section 8 of the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1961* is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“ 8.—(1.) The Minister administering an Ordinance may, by writing under his hand, delegate all or any of his powers and functions under regulations made under the Ordinance. Delegation  
of powers and  
functions  
under  
Regulations.

“ (2.) A power or function so delegated may be exercised or performed by the delegate in accordance with the instrument of delegation.

“ (3.) A delegation under this section is revocable at will and does not prevent the exercise of a power or a performance of a function by the Minister.

“ (4.) The operation of sub-section (1.) of this section is subject to any contrary intention in the Ordinance or regulations under the Ordinance.”
