

## FISH PROTECTION

## No. 11 of 1964.

An Ordinance to amend the *Fish Protection Ordinance* 1929-1949.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Fish Protection Ordinance* 1964.\*

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Fish Protection Ordinance* 1929-1949† as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Fish Protection Ordinance* 1929-1964.

2. Section twenty-four A of the *Fish Protection Ordinance* 1929-1949 is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“24A.—(1.) A person who is not the holder of a licence under section twenty-four E of this Ordinance shall not fish in the Territory of Jervis Bay or in the territorial waters of that Territory except—

Prohibition of

- (a) by means of a single line with not more than two hooks attached;
- (b) by means of a rod and line;
- (c) by means of a landing net or gaff (consisting of a plain metal hook without a barb) used in connexion with a line or rod and line; or
- (d) subject to the next succeeding sub-section, by means of a spear or spear gun.

“(2.) A person shall not fish with a spear or spear gun in the waters between St. George’s Head and the western end of Cave Beach.

Penalty: Twenty pounds.”.
