

ADVISORY COUNCIL

No. 6 of 1967

An Ordinance to amend the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1966*.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1967*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1966*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1967*.

2.—(1.) Section 9 of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1966* is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“9.—(1.) The Chairman of the Council, if an elected member of the Council, shall be paid an allowance at the rate of Six hundred dollars per annum. Allowance to elected members.

“ (2.) Each elected member of the Council, not being the Chairman of the Council, shall be paid an allowance at the rate of Three hundred dollars per annum.”.

(2.) A person who held office as an elected member of the Advisory Council in the period that commenced on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, and ended on the twenty-third day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, shall, in respect of the term during which he so held office in that period, be paid an additional allowance in accordance with the next succeeding sub-section.

(3.) The additional allowance shall be paid at a rate equal to the difference between the rate of allowance payable to that person in respect of the term during which he so held that office in that period under the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936*, as amended and in force during that term, and the rate of allowance prescribed in respect of the holder of that office by that Ordinance as amended up to and including this Ordinance.
