

HOUSING

No. 19 of 1969

An Ordinance to amend the *Housing Ordinance* 1928-1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance* 1969.* Short title
and citation

(2.) The *Housing Ordinance* 1928-1959,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Housing Ordinance* 1928-1969.

2. After section 4 of the *Housing Ordinance* 1928-1959 the following section is inserted:—

“4A.—(1.) The corporation established by this Ordinance by the name of the Commissioner for Housing may, by writing under its seal, give to a person a power of attorney authorizing that person — Commissioner
may give
power of
attorney.

(a) to exercise all or any of the powers of the corporation, whether conferred by this Ordinance or otherwise; and

(b) to execute any instrument relating to the exercise of such a power.

“ (2.) A power of attorney given under this section shall not contain a provision authorizing the person to whom it is given to appoint a substitute, delegate or sub-attorney.

“ (3.) Subject to the last preceding sub-section, the *Powers of Attorney Ordinance* 1956-1957 applies to, and in relation to, a power of attorney given under this section.”
