NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE 1971

1.--(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Nurses Registration short title and citation. Ordinance 1971.*

(2.) The Nurses Registration Ordinance $1933-1970^{+}_{1}$ is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933-1971.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting Interpretation. in sub-section (1.), after the definition of "registered nurse", the following definition:—

"' the Assistant Director' means the person for the time being occupying, or performing the duties of, the office of Assistant Director, Department of Health, Australian Capital Territory; ".

3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Members of the Board. from sub-sections (1.) and (3.) the word "Director" and inserting in its stead the words " Assistant Director "
