To amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1971*, as amended by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1972*.

### SEAT OF GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATION) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance (No. 2) 1972*.\*

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1971*,† as amended by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1972*,‡ is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Section 1 of the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1972* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1972*.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words “the Minister of State for the Interior” and inserting in their stead the words “the Minister of State for the Capital Territory”;

- (b) by omitting from sub-section (4A.) the words “ the Minister of State for Education and Science ” and inserting in their stead the words “ the Minister of State for Education ”;
- (c) by omitting from sub-section (5.) the words “ the Minister of State for the Interior ” and inserting in their stead the words “ the Minister of State for the Capital Territory ”; and
- (d) by omitting from sub-section (6.) the words “ by the Minister of State for the Interior ” and inserting in their stead the words “ , on or after the date of commencement of the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance (No. 2) 1972*, by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory ”.
