### POLICE PENSIONS ORDINANCE 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Pensions Ordinance 1972*.\*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Pensions Ordinance 1958-1968*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Pensions Ordinance 1958-1972*.

2. The Second Schedule to the *Police Pensions Ordinance 1958-1968* is repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:—
