To amend the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969*.

### ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1973*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title and citation.

(2) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969*,<sup>†</sup> as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1973*.

2. After section 4 of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969* the following sections are inserted:—

“4A. (1) This section applies to, and in relation to, a person who on the thirtieth day of September, 1973, is, or is to be deemed to be, an elected member of the Council. Extension of term of office of certain elected members.

“ (2) The Council may, on or before the thirty-first day of July, 1973, advise the Minister that it is desirable that the terms of office of the elected members of the Council be extended for such period not exceeding twelve months as is specified by the Council.

“ (3) If the Council advises the Minister in pursuance of subsection (2), the Minister shall, by notice published in the *Gazette* not later than the thirty-first day of August, 1973, declare that a person who, on the thirtieth day of September, 1973, is, or is to be deemed to be, an elected member of the Council shall continue to hold office as an elected member until the expiration of a period specified in the notice.

“ (4) The period specified in a notice published in pursuance of sub-section (3) shall be the period specified by the Council in its advice to the Minister.

“ (5) Notwithstanding sub-section (3) of section 4, on and after the date of publication, in accordance with sub-section (3) of this section, of a notice in the *Gazette*, a person to whom this section applies shall hold office as an elected member of the Council until the expiration of the period specified in the notice.

“ 4B. Where, on the thirtieth day of September, 1973—

- (a) an elected member of the Council has ceased to hold office and no person has been appointed to the vacant office; and
- (b) a notice has been published in the *Gazette* in accordance with sub-section (3) of section 4A,

section 6 applies as if the term of office of the elected member had been a period expiring at the expiration of the period referred to in sub-section (3) of section 4A.”.
