CANBERRA RETAIL MARKET TRUST ORDINANCE 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Retail Market Trust Ordinance 1974*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Canberra Retail Market Trust Ordinance 1971-1973*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Retail Market Trust Ordinance 1971-1974*.

2. The First Schedule to the *Canberra Retail Market Trust Ordinance 1971-1973* is amended by omitting the words "Pre-packed fresh fish" and substituting the words "Fish and other seafoods". First Schedule.
